

**ARIZONA-NEVADA ACADEMY OF SCIENCE
GRADUATE GRANT-IN-AID**



The Arizona-Nevada Academy of Science will award Grants-In-Aid in amounts up to \$300.00 to students who are enrolled in a graduate program at one of the universities in Nevada or Arizona and who are members of the Academy. The grant funds may be used for any activity directly associated with an ongoing research project (equipment purchase, supplies, publication of research results, travel to field site, *etc.*) The funds may not be used for travel to scientific meetings, publication costs or any other activity not directly associated with the research. All grants and scholarships awarded by the Arizona-Nevada Academy of Science are intended for the recipient only, and cannot be used for administrative or institutional services of any kind. Grant funds will be disbursed to the affiliated institution.

Grants are reviewed two times a year but an individual only may be awarded on a one time per year basis. Deadlines for submission are **March 15** and **November 15** of each year.

In addition to completing this form, applicants should send the scholarship chairperson three copies of the following materials: (1) a well-written, one-page research proposal and (2) at least one letter of support.

The one-page research summary should include the following information:

- problem to be studied (title and description)
- where problem will be studied
- specific purpose for grant funds
- support in time, materials, etc., for the proposed project from the applicant's own institution or funds.
- name(s) of co-investigator(s).

The applicant agrees to submit a report (maximum of eight pages in length) to the Arizona-Nevada Academy of Science after the completion of the research or within one year after receipt of the grant, whichever is first. These reports may be published in the ANAS Journal, and on the ANAS Web Page <http://www.geo.arizona.edu/anas/awards/>. If the paper is selected for publication in JANAS, page charges will be waived.
